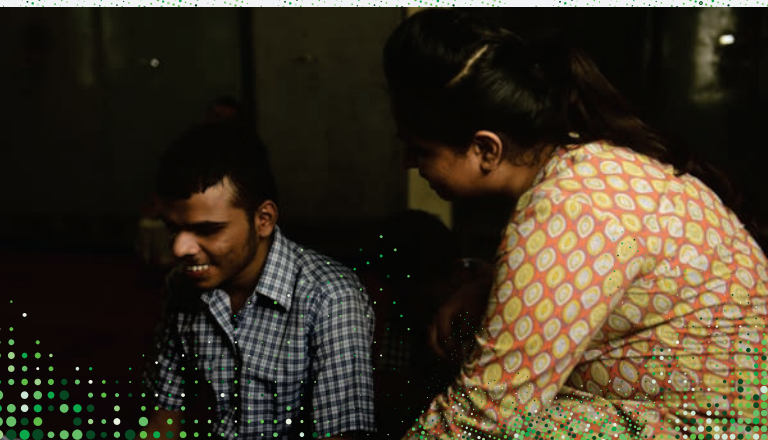


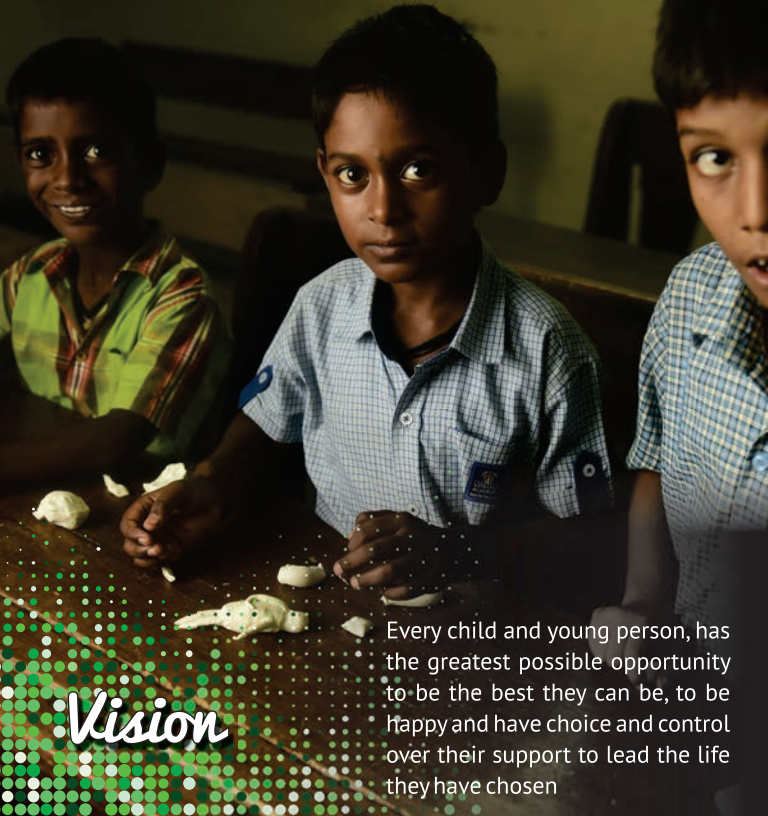
Our Story of Care

Deepak Foundation, after over 30 years of service in the fields of healthcare, education, skills and capacity building, and sustainable livelihood, has now ventured into serving children with special needs. Samaj Suraksha Sankul is a Public Private Partnership (PPP) between Deepak Foundation and Department of Social Justice and Empowerment (Govt. of Gujarat), under which the Foundation has undertaken the operations and management of the Institute.

Samaj Suraksha Sankul is a residential and support institute for visually impaired, physically challenged, and children in need of protection and care. The Institute operates a school for visually impaired children.

Sankul rehabilitates children with special needs and empowers them to live a life of dignity and independence and becoming productive members of the society.

Mission



Visually Impaired

We provide residential facilities to boys (aged 8-18) with varied levels of visual impairment. Sankul also operates a primary school for boys and girls with visual impairment. We pursue regular vision assessments and create personalised action plans for all visually impaired. A special emphasis is laid to give them computer training so they can be prepared to take up high skilled jobs in the future.

Physically Challenged

Physically challenged boys are provided with residential facilities and are educated in a private school outside the institute. We assess children for different degrees of physical disabilities and provide them with mobility aides, physiotherapy, and other necessary interventions. They are active participants of various district and state level competitions and have often emerged as winners.



Children's Home for Boys

Sankul provides a home to children in need of care and protection. We ensure that they receive good quality of education along with opportunities for overall development. Our in house professionals ensure that the children feel accepted and develop a sense of belonging towards Sankul. We train them to be future responsible citizens by entrusting them with responsibilities such as cleanliness, meal planning, discipline, gardening, etc.
