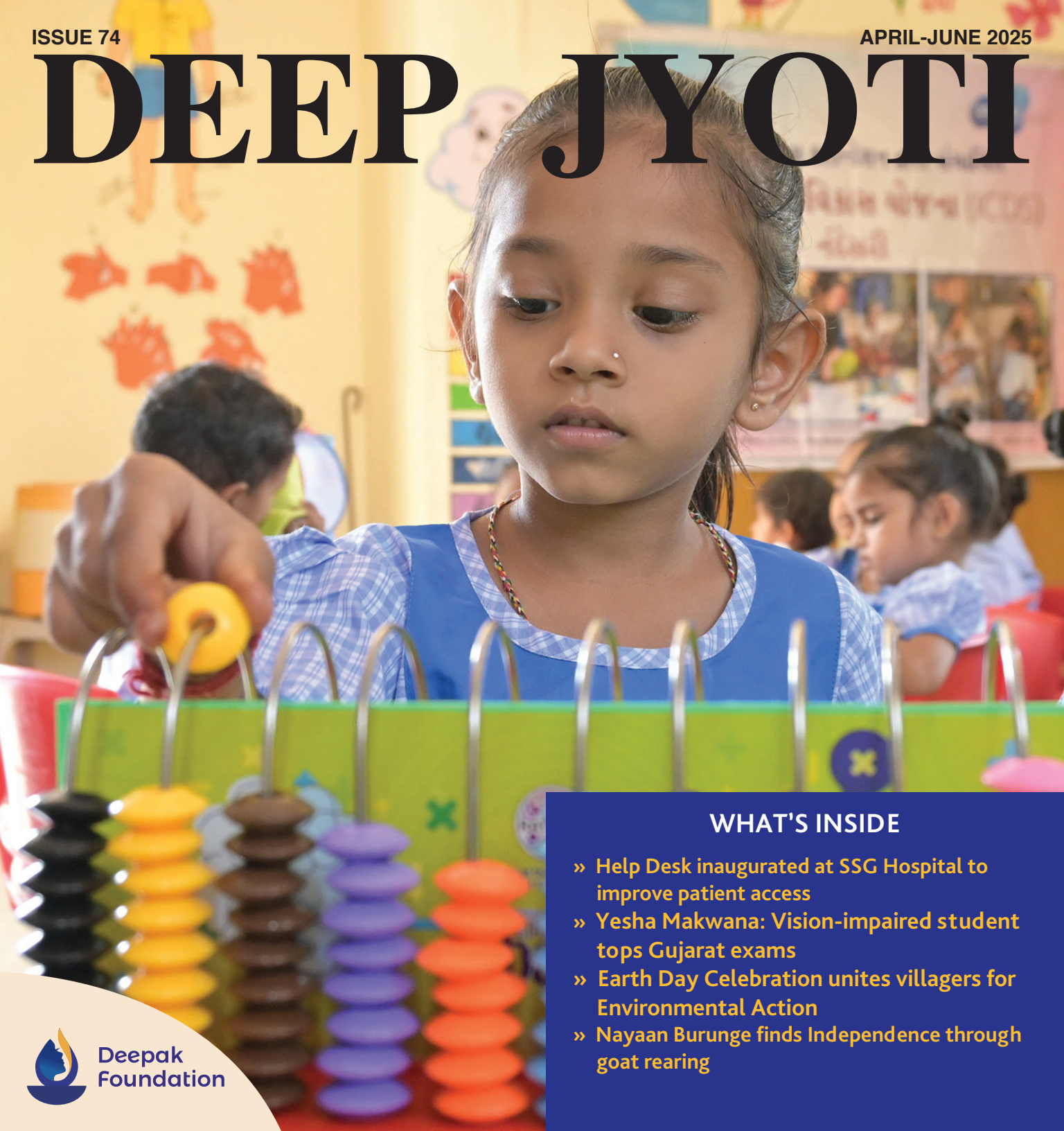

Help Desk inaugurated at SSG Hospital to improve patient access

Public-Private Partnership to Enhance Healthcare Navigation

Deepak Foundation, in collaboration with SSG Hospital, Vadodara, inaugurated a Help Desk at the Rukmani Department to provide streamlined support for hospital visitors. The desk will assist patients in navigating procedures and accessing government health schemes like PMJAY and ABHA.

The inauguration ceremony was graced by Dr. R.N. Daveshwar (Hospital Superintendent), Dr. Ashish Gokhle (Dean & HoD), and Dr. H.S. Chauhan (RMO). This initiative is part of a broader effort to improve patient experience and ensure equitable access to government health entitlements.

"The Help Desk is a vital step in closing the information gap for our patients," said Dr. Gokhle. "It brings empathy and efficiency to public healthcare."

Sankul School Student Scores 86.71% Using Laptop Assistance

Yesha Makwana, a visually impaired student from Sankul School and Resource Center, Vadodara, secured the highest marks (86.71%) in Gujarat's Class 12 board exams among Divyang students using laptops. Her achievement was made possible through assistive technologies and the Foundation's customized learning support.

"Sankul provided me with Braille materials and ensured I could take my exams digitally," Yesha shared. "Now, I dream of studying History and becoming an IAS officer."
